OBJECT: LEED

"In LEED Canada Reference Guide 2009, we are asked to provide information on the locations where the raw materials comes from. This information is then used to calculate the Regional Materials content of the product installed (MR5.1 and MR5.2 credits).

For confidentiality reasons and competitiveness, Soprema inc. can not disclose the actual locations where raw materials are procured. We can however confirm that the weight percentage of the product's raw materials content stated on our LEED Data Sheet comes from raw materials obtained within 800 km from our manufacturing location if transported by truck or within 2400 km if transported by boat or railways."

Regional materials compose 69.3% of product weight from Drummondville, QC.
