INSTALLATION

| Storage | 12 months in the original container. Store in a cool, dry place, between 10 ° C (50 ° F) and 40 ° C (104 ° F). Keep from freezing. |
| Minimum Application Temperature | 10 ° C (50 ° F) |
| Surface Preparation | Sweep away all dirt and debris from the surface. First, treat the oil spot with RESISTO CLEANER AND DEGREASER (follow the instructions supplied with the product). |
| Installation Prerequisite | The surface must be in good condition. |
| Installation | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pour the CLEANER AND DEGREASER (for oil and grease spots) on the surface to be treated. 2. Vigorously brush the surface with a stiff brush or a broom. 3. Rinse thoroughly with a garden hose while the surface is still damp. 4. Repeat this step until there are no more bubbles in the rinsing water. 5. After cleaning the surface, apply OIL SPOT PRIMER (follow the instructions provided with the product). |
| Tricks / Tips | Allow product to cure completely before applying OIL SPOT PRIMER. To ensure long-lasting protection of the asphalt surface, seal it using a RESISTO driveway sealer. If the asphalt surface is softened by oil or gasoline, it is suggested to remove the damaged area and to repair it with RESISTO ASPHALT REPAIR. |
| Recommendations/ Limitations | Apply without dilution or thinning. |
